The Cybersecurity Concentration is designed to help students in the Business Major understand the
threats that foreign and domestic adversaries present to the business world. This concentration

introduces students to the technology used to secure computer systems as well as the vulnerabilities that exist in those systems which represent business risk. Processes and technology to help mitigate those risks are introduced along with strategies for organizational resiliency. Students will learn industry best practices for protecting the confidentiality, integrity and availability of information.
