Students will have the opportunity to decide which track they want to pursue. Networking or Security Design *If a student chooses the Security Design Path (CYB105/CYB205), they will have the opportunity to sit for the Comptia Security+ Certification.

*If they choose the Networking Path (CYB 120/220 path), they will have the opportunity to sit for two certifications: The Comptia Networking+ certification and/or the Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA).

Students who successfully complete the concentration can use CYB 220 OR CYB 205 along with CYB 215 towards their 300 level core elective.

NOTE: Students who complete any DEV or bridge courses while attending Lackawanna may require extra time to complete this concentration because of the limited number of elective classes in the first two years of the Criminal Justice Bachelor's Degree.
