Developmental/Additional Requirements:

Based on assessment testing results, students are placed in appropriate level courses (developmental or college level). Students without SAT / ACT / in-house assessment scores will be scheduled for three developmental courses (Reading for College, Basic Writing Skills, and Basic Math Skills). These courses must be successfully completed before a student may enroll in required English / math courses.

Students entering Lackawanna College who are not qualified to enter directly into the Pre Allied Health program can pursue Professional Studies with the Pre Allied Health intent for the first semester or year. Professional Studies with a Pre Allied Health Intent (PSAH) students need to work with their academic advisor to review the pre allied health program guidelines/ requirements. At the completion of this coursework, if the student is still not eligible for admission to the pre allied health program, he/she must declare a new major. Students also need to be aware that, if accepted into the pre allied health program, they will not be able to complete the remaining coursework in a two-year timeframe.
